The City of Spokane is launching a transportation and zoning analysis for Grand Boulevard's core neighborhood district. This study will allow for recommended improvements that meet the anticipated needs and growth of this neighborhood district.



EXPECTED TO BEGIN IN AUGUST OF 2019, THIS STUDY'S GOAL IS TO:

REVIEW: Traffic patterns & safety on Grand Blvd.

DEVELOP: Understanding of bicycle & pedestrian needs.

EVALUATE: Concepts of lane reduction, bike lanes, wider sidewalks, and green infrastructure. Analyze residential & retail data and conduct market analysis for redevelopment potential.

STUDY: Land use and zoning boundaries with Comprehensive Plan goals in mind.

WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW: The City collected traffic data including bike and pedestrian counts while school was in session.
