



Did you know?

Property owners and residents are responsible for maintaining a free and clear sidewalk for the safety of all pedestrians. Here's how to do your part this winter:

- Try to clear your sidewalks by 9 a.m. after a snowfall.
- Clear a 36-inch pedestrian path on your sidewalk to allow for safe travel.
- Consider creating a pedestrian path even if a sidewalk doesn't exist.
- Clear snow from around curb ramps, hydrants, storm drains, and mailboxes to aid daily services.
- Help clear neighborhood bus stops and school walking routes to be a good neighbor.

Make sure you know who in your neighborhood might need help with shoveling or other winter work and offer to help. Contact 3-1-1 for seniors or disabled individuals who need more help.
